INSTRUCTIONS:


- 1) Download and print this pack.



Bluey and her friends are hiding. Cross them off as you find them.








MAGIC ASPARAGUS

- 3. Cut out your magic asparagus.


 Now you're ready to turn your friends and family into any animal you want, just like Bluey.

- 2. Download and print out the name badge (ask a grownup for help).
- 3. Colour in your badge and write your new name on it.
- 4. Ask a grown up to help you cut it out.
- 5. Tape a safety pin to the back of the badge and ask a grown up to pin it to your top.
- 6. You're ready. Time to try out your new name, Telemachus.






