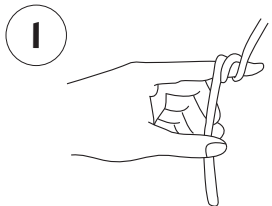

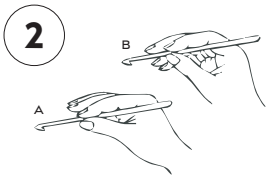

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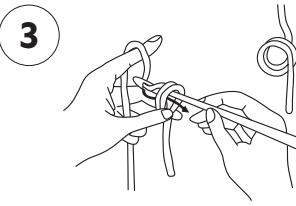
BEFORE BEGINNING THIS PROJECT, YOU'LL HAVE TO LEARN SOME BASIC CROCHET TECHNIQUES: MAGIC LOOP, DOUBLE CROCHET AND FASTENING OFF. TO START WITH, USE THE CROCHET HOOK TO CREATE A MAGIC LOOP.



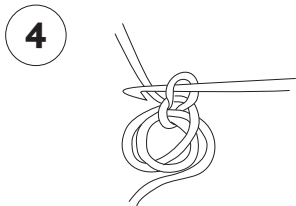
FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, WRAP THE YARN AROUND YOUR FINGER TWICE. LEAVE AT LEAST A 15cm TAIL, UNTIL YOU BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THIS METHOD.



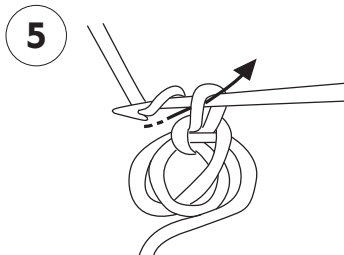
USE YOUR THUMB AND INDEX FINGER TO HOLD THE HOOK. LEAVE 4cm FROM THE TIP OF THE HOOK TO YOUR FINGERS, REFER TO PICTURE 'A'. PLACE YOUR MIDDLE FINGER ON THE HOOK 1.5cm AWAY FROM THE TIP. KEEP THE OTHER TWO FINGERS CLOSE TO THE CROCHET HOOK. JUST AS PICTURE 'B' SHOWS.



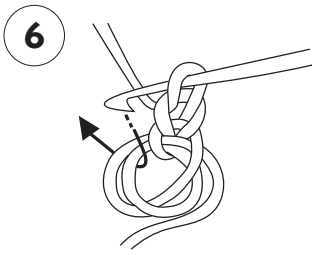
FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, HOLD THE LOOP WITH 2 FINGERS THEN GRAB THE WORKING YARN WITH THE HOOK AND PULL IT BACK THROUGH THE LOOP.



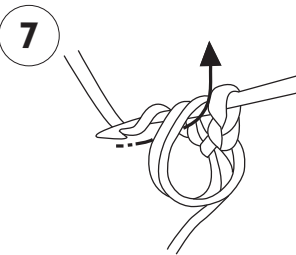
YOU WILL HAVE ONE LOOP ON THE HOOK.



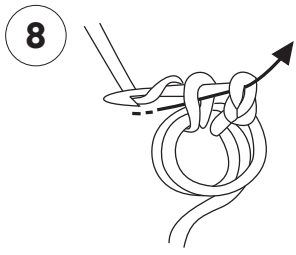
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH THE HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



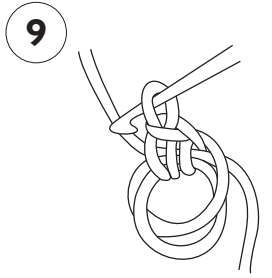
INSERT THE HOOK PASSING THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW. THIS CREATES A CHAIN STITCH.



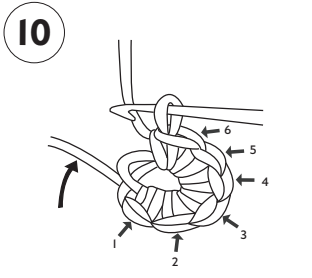
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



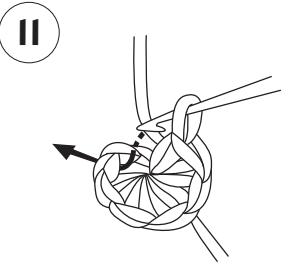
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH BOTH LOOPS WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



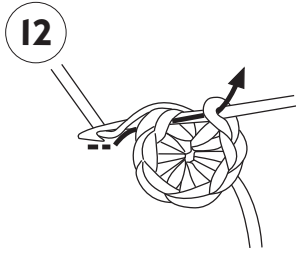
DOUBLE CROCHET MADE, PLEASE NOTE THESE TWO STEPS MAKE ONE STITCH.



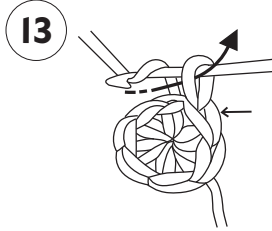
KEEP DRAWING THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP FROM THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW. REPEAT STEPS 7 & 8 SIX MORE TIMES, COMPLETING 7DC.



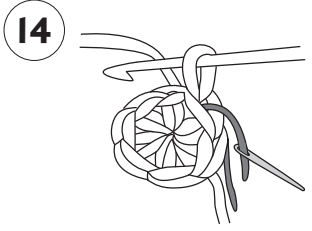
INSERT THE HOOK THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



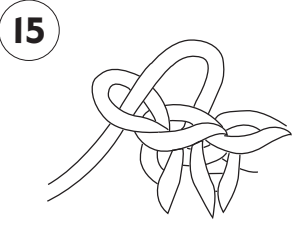
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW AGAIN. A SLIP STITCH IS MADE.



WHEN YOU FINISH THE FIRST ROUND, YOU MAY USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE WHEN CHANGING THE COLOUR OF THREAD TO MARK WHERE THE BEGINNING OF THE ROUND IS.



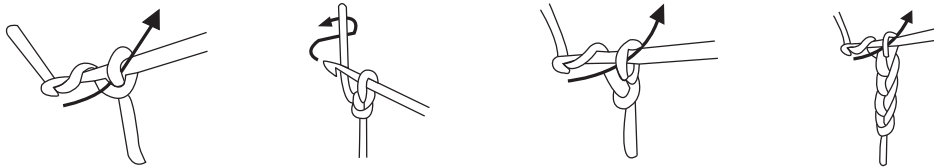
WHEN YOU REACH THE LAST STITCH IN THE ROUND OR ROW, CUT OFF THE YARN LEAVING A 12cm TAIL. SLIP THE END OF THE YARN THROUGH THE STITCH AND PULL IT TO TIGHTEN THE LOOP. WEAVE THE TAIL INTO YOUR WORK.

R= ROUND OR ROW
ST= STITCH
DC= DOUBLE CROCHET
INC= INCREASE
SS= SLIP STITCH
CH= CHAIN STITCH
HTR= HALF TREBLE CROCHET
CLO= THROUGH CENTRE LOOPS ONLY
[O]= ORANGE YARN
[BR]= BROWN YARN

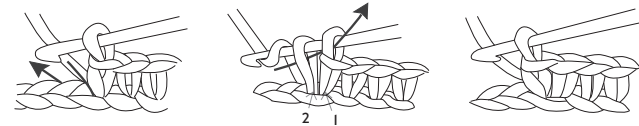
CH CHAIN STITCH



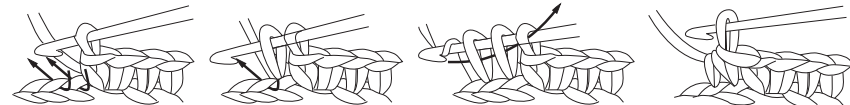
DC DOUBLE CROCHET

ADDITIONAL STITCH IN THE SAME SPACE MEANS YOU REPEAT A DOUBLE CROCHET TWICE FOR THE SAME STITCH SPACE LIKE THE ILLUSTRATION.



SS SLIP STITCH



HTR HALF TREBLE CROCHET



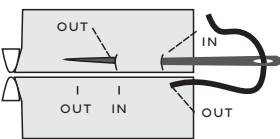
TO MAKE THE PUMPKIN

YOU WILL USE ORANGE YARN [O] FOR THE PUMPKIN.

ROWS	PATTERN INSTRUCTION	STITCH	YARN
R1	49CH	49	[O]
R2	48HTR	48	[O]
R3-R85	CLO(48HTR)	48	[O]

CUT THE YARN LEAVING A LONG TAIL TO ATTACH BOTH ENDS OF THE PUMPKIN TOGETHER.

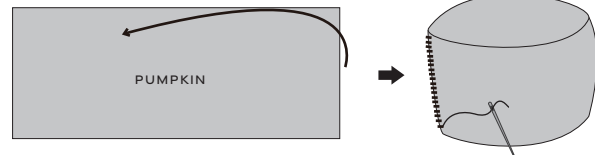
JOIN ALL PARTS TOGETHER:



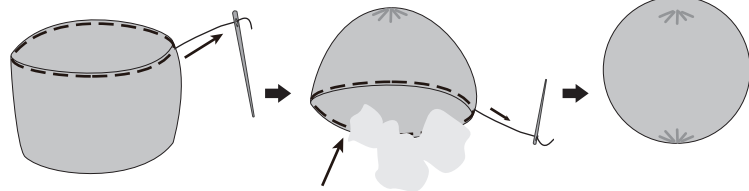
INVISIBLE STITCH



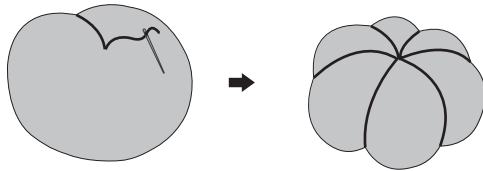
RUNNING STITCH



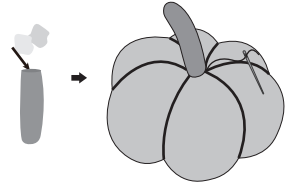
PREPARE THE PUMPKIN BODY AND USE THE RUNNING STITCH METHOD TO SEW BOTH ENDS OF THE PUMPKIN BODY TOGETHER.



USE THE RUNNING STITCH METHOD TO SEW AROUND THE TOP OF THE PUMPKIN THEN PULL THE YARN TIGHT TO CRUMPLE UP THE TOP OF THE PUMPKIN. AFTER TYING A KNOT, TUCK THE YARN INSIDE THE PUMPKIN. ONCE YOU'VE FILLED IT WITH STUFFING, USE THE SAME METHOD TO CLOSE THE OTHER END.



THE YARN IS THREADED OUT FROM THE BOTTOM OF THE PUMPKIN (LEAVING A TAIL), THEN THREADED THROUGH TO THE TOP, AND THEN BACK THROUGH THE BOTTOM TO THE TOP AGAIN, PULLING THE YARN TIGHT. AFTER COMPLETING 6 ROUNDS OF THREADING, ENSURE THE PUMPKIN SHAPE IS TIGHT AND EVEN. YOU CAN ADJUST THE LENGTH OR POSITION OF THE TAIL YARN TO MAKE THE PUMPKIN MORE AESTHETICALLY PLEASING.



STUFF THE PUMPKIN STEM, THEN PLACE THE STEM ON TOP OF THE PUMPKIN. USING THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE STEM, SEW IT TO THE PUMPKIN BY STITCHING IN AND OUT BETWEEN THE STEM AND THE PUMPKIN. USE YOUR NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH. ONCE THE STEM IS SECURELY ATTACHED, PULL THE YARN INSIDE THE PUMPKIN AND LEAVE IT THERE.
