

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
BEFORE BEGINNING THIS PROJECT, YOU'LL HAVE TO LEARN SOME BASIC CROCHET TECHNIQUES: MAGIC LOOP, DOUBLE CROCHET AND FASTENING OFF. TO START WITH, USE THE CROCHET HOOK TO CREATE A MAGIC LOOP.




FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, WRAP THE YARN AROUND YOUR FINGER TWICE. LEAVE AT LEAST A 15cm TAIL, UNTIL YOU BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THIS METHOD.




USE YOUR THUMB AND INDEX FINGER TO HOLD THE HOOK. LEAVE 4cm FROM THE TIP OF THE HOOK TO YOUR FINGERS, REFER TO PICTURE 'A'. PLACE YOUR MIDDLE FINGER ON THE HOOK I.5cm AWAY FROM THE TIP. KEEP THE OTHER TWO FINGERS CLOSE TO THE CROCHET HOOK, JUST AS PICTURE 'B' SHOWS.




FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, HOLD THE LOOP WITH 2 FINGERS THEN GRAB THE WORKING YARN WITH THE HOOK AND PULL IT BACK THROUGH THE LOOP.




YOU WILL HAVE ONE LOOP ON THE HOOK.




PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH THE HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.






PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.






DOUBLE CROCHET MADE, PLEASE NOTE THESE TWO STEPS MAKE ONE STITCH.






INSERT THE HOOK THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.




PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW AGAIN. A SLIP STITCH IS MADE.



WHEN YOU FINISH THE FIRST ROUND, YOU MAY USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE WHEN CHANGING THE COLOUR OF THREAD TO MARK WHERE THE BEGINNING OF THE ROUND IS.




WHEN YOU REACH THE LAST STITCH IN THE ROUND OR ROW, CUT OFF THE YARN LEAVING A 12cm TAIL, SLIP THE END OF THE YARN THROUGH THE STITCH AND PULL IT TO TIGHTEN THE LOOP. WEAVE THE TAIL INTO YOUR WORK

HEAD ON THE BODY


STUFF THE BODY, THEN PLACE THE HEAD ON TOP OF THE BODY. USING THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE BODY, SEW IN AND OUT TO ATTACH THE HEAD TO THE BODY. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC. SEW ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE HEAD IS SECURELY ATTACHED, THEN PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT THE YARN.

ARMS ON THE BODY

PLACE THE FIRST ARM IN THE POSITION WHERE YOU WANT IT TO BE ATTACHED TO THE BODY. USING THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE ARM, SEW BACK AND FORTH BETWEEN THE ARM TOP AND THE BODY TO SECURE THE ARM. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC. SEW ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE HAND IS SECURELY ATTACHED, THEN PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT THE YARN. REPEAT THE SAME STEPS TO SEW ON THE SECOND ARM.





NOSE ON THE HEAD

STUFF THE NOSE, THEN PLACE THE NOSE IN THE APPROPRIATE POSITION ON THE HEAD. USING THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE NOSE, SEW IN AND OUT TO ATTACH THE NOSE TO THE HEAD. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC. SEW ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE NOSE IS SECURELY ATTACHED, THEN PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT THE YARN.





MOUTH, CHEEKS AND BUTTONS ON THE BODY

THREAD BLACK YARN [B] THROUGH THE PLASTIC NEEDLE, INSERT THE NEEDLE FROM THE BACK OF THE HEAD TO THE FRONT AT THE POSITION OF THE MOUTH, LEAVING A TAIL WITHOUT PULLING THE YARN COMPLETELY THROUGH. USE THE FLY STITCH TO EMBROIDER THE MOUTH. AFTER FINISHING, PULL THE YARN BACK OUT FROM THE ORIGINAL INSERTION POINT. THE A KNOT WITH THE TWO TAIL ENDS, TRIM THE EXCESS, AND USE THE NEEDLE TO TUCK THE TAIL ENDS INTO THE HEAD. USE A SIMILAR METHOD TO STITCH A STRAIGHT LINE FOR THE CHEEKE AND CROSSES FOR THE PULTONS. FOR THE CHEEKS AND CROSSES FOR THE BUTTONS.





HAT ON THE HEAD

STUFF THE HAT, THEN PLACE IT ON TOP OF THE HEAD. USING THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE HAT, SEW IN AND OUT TO ATTACH THE HAT TO THE HEAD. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC. SEW ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE HAT IS SECURELY ATTACHED, THEN PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT THE YARN. THEN, WRAP THE SCARF AROUND THE SNOWMAN'S NECK. FINALLY, USE GLUE GUN/GLUE DOT/GLUE TO ATTACH THE POM POM TO THE TOP OF THE HAT. WITH THAT, THE SNOWMAN IS COMPLETE.
