BEFORE BEGINNING THIS PROJECT, YOU'LL HAVE TO LEARN SOME BASIC CROCHET TECHNIQUES: MAGIC LOOP, DOUBLE CROCHET AND FASTENING OFF. TO START WITH, USE THE CROCHET HOOK TO CREATE A MAGIC LOOP.

1

FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, WRAP THE YARN AROUND YOUR FINGER TWICE. LEAVE AT LEAST A 15cm TAIL, UNTIL YOU BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THIS METHOD.

USE YOUR THUMB AND INDEX FINGER TO HOLD THE HOOK. LEAVE 4cm FROM THE TIP OF THE HOOK TO YOUR FINGERS. REFER TO PICTURE 'A'. PLACE YOUR MIDDLE FINGER ON THE HOOK 1.5cm AWAY FROM THE TIP. KEEP THE OTHER TWO FINGERS CLOSE TO THE CROCHET HOOK. JUST AS PICTURE 'B' SHOWS.

FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, HOLD THE LOOP WITH 2 FINGERS THEN GRAB THE WORKING YARN WITH THE HOOK AND PULL IT BACK THROUGH THE LOOP.

YOU WILL HAVE ONE LOOP ON THE HOOK.

5

PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH THE HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.

6

INSERT THE HOOK PASSING THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW. THIS CREATES A CHAIN STITCH.

7

PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.

8

PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH BOTH LOOPS WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.

9

DOUBLE CROCHET MADE. PLEASE NOTE THESE TWO STEPS MAKE ONE STITCH.

10

KEEP DRAWING THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP FROM THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW. REPEAT STEPS 7 & 8 SIX MORE TIMES, COMPLETING 7DC.

11

INSERT THE HOOK THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.

12

PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.

13

PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW AGAIN. A SLIP STITCH IS MADE.

14

WHEN YOU FINISH THE FIRST ROUND, YOU MAY USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE WHEN CHANGING THE COLOUR OF THREAD TO MARK WHERE THE BEGINNING OF THE ROUND IS.

15

WHEN YOU REACH THE LAST STITCH IN THE ROUND OR ROW, CUT OFF THE YARN LEAVING A 12cm TAIL. SLIP THE END OF THE YARN THROUGH THE STITCH AND PULL IT TO TIGHTEN THE LOOP. WEAWE THE TAIL INTO YOUR WORK.

YOU WILL USE BROWN YARN [BR] AND BEIGE YARN [BE] FOR THE HEAD.

BEGIN STUFFING THE HEAD.

FINISH STUFFING THE HEAD. SLIP STITCH THROUGH THE NEXT STITCH. CUT THE YARN, AND PULL THROUGH THE LOOP TO TIGHTEN. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE HEAD. CUT OFF THE EXCESS YARN.

TO MAKE THE BODY

YOU WILL USE BROWN YARN [BR] FOR THE BODY.

FINISH STUFFING THE BODY, THEN CUT THE YARN LEAVING A LONG TAIL TO ATTACH THE OPENING OF THE BODY. SEW THE BODY SEAM.

TO MAKE THE EARS

YOU WILL USE BROWN YARN [BR] FOR THE EARS.

CUT THE YARN AND LEAVE A LONG TAIL TO ATTACH THE EARS TO THE HEAD.

ATTACHING THE HIGHLAND COW

JOIN ALL PARTS TOGETHER:

NOSE ON THE HEAD

STUFF THE NOSE, THEN PLACE THE NOSE IN THE POSITION YOU WANT IT TO SIT ON THE HIGHLAND COW'S HEAD. USING THE TAIL YOU SAVED AFTER COMPLETING THE HEAD, ATTACH IT TO THE NOSE BY SEWING THE TAIL IN AND OUT ON THE HEAD. USE YOUR NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH. ONCE YOU HAVE SEWN ALL THE WAY AROUND AND THE NOSE IS ATTACHED, PULL YOUR YARN INSIDE THE HEAD AND LEAVE IT IN THERE.

HORNS ON THE HEAD

PLACE THE FIRST HORN IN THE POSITION YOU WANT IT TO SIT ON THE HIGHLAND COW'S HEAD. USING THE TAIL YOU SAVED AFTER COMPLETING THE HORN, ATTACH IT TO THE HEAD BY SEWING THE TAIL IN AND OUT ON THE HEAD. USE YOUR NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH. ONCE YOU HAVE SEWN ALL THE WAY AROUND AND THE HORN IS ATTACHED, PULL YOUR YARN INSIDE THE HEAD AND LEAVE IT IN THERE. REPEAT THIS FOR THE SECOND HORN.

EARS ON THE HEAD

FOLD ONE END OF ONE OF THE EARS WITH THE TAIL YARN IN HALF AND USE A NEEDLE TO PASS THROUGH THREE PAIRS OF STITCHES TO SEW THE ENDS OF THE EAR TOGETHER. THEN, PLACE IT BELOW THE HORN ON THE HIGHLAND COW'S HEAD. ATTACH IT TO THE HEAD BY SEWING BACK AND FORTH TO SECURE THE EAR. USE YOUR NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH. ONCE YOU HAVE COMPLETED THE STEP AND THE EAR IS ATTACHED, PULL THE YARN INSIDE THE HEAD AND LEAVE IT THERE. THEN, REPEAT THE SAME STEPS TO ATTACH THE SECOND EAR.

NOSTRILS AND MOUTH ON THE HEAD

FINALLY, USE BLACK YARN TO STITCH THE NOSTRILS AND MOUTH. INSERT THE YARN FROM THE BACK OF THE HEAD TO THE NOSE (DO NOT PULL THE YARN COMPLETELY THROUGH; LEAVE A SMALL TAIL AT THE BACK). SEW THE NOSTRILS AND MOUTH, THEN BRING THE YARN BACK OUT FROM THE INSERTION POINT. TIE A KNOT WITH THE TAIL YARN, CUT OFF THE EXCESS, AND USE THE NEEDLE TO TUCK THE REMAINING YARN INTO THE HEAD.

HEAD ON THE BODY

PLACE THE HEAD IN THE POSITION WHERE YOU WANT IT TO SIT ON THE HIGHLAND COW'S BODY. USING THE TAIL YARN LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE HEAD, ATTACH IT TO THE BODY BY SEWING BACK AND FORTH TO SECURE THE HEAD. USE YOUR NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH. ONCE YOU HAVE SEWN ALL THE WAY AROUND AND THE HEAD IS ATTACHED, PULL THE YARN INSIDE THE BODY AND LEAVE IT THERE.

LEGS ON THE BODY

PLACE THE FIRST LEG IN THE POSITION YOU WANT IT TO SIT ON THE HIGHLAND COW'S BODY. USING THE TAIL YOU SAVED AFTER COMPLETING THE LEG, ATTACH IT TO THE BODY BY SEWING THE TAIL IN AND OUT ON THE BODY. USE YOUR NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH. ONCE YOU HAVE SEWN ALL THE WAY AROUND AND THE LEG IS ATTACHED, PULL YOUR YARN INSIDE THE LEG AND LEAVE IT IN THERE. REPEAT THE SAME STEPS TO SECURE THE REMAINING THREE LEGS.

TO MAKE THE NOSE

YOU WILL USE BEIGE YARN [BE] FOR THE NOSE.

ROUND	PATTERN INSTRUCTION	STITCH	YARN
R1	6CH, TURN 2(1NC, 4DC, 1NC)	16	[BE]
R2-R3	16DC	16	[BE]

CUT THE YARN AND LEAVE A LONG TAIL TO ATTACH THE NOSE TO THE HEAD.

HAIR, TAIL AND BELL

CUT THE BEIGE YARN INTO 10cm SEGMENTS, THEN CROCHET THEM IN A DESIRED POSITION ON THE HIGHLAND COW'S HEAD. INSERT THE HOOK INTO ONE STITCH, THEN PULL IT OUT THROUGH AN ADJACENT STITCH, MAKING THE MIDDLE OF THE YARN SEGMENT WITH BOTH ENDS LEFT OUTSIDE (THE SEGMENT IS FOLDED IN HALF). CROCHET THROUGH THE MIDDLE HOLE AND PULL BOTH ENDS OF THE YARN TO TIGHTEN. USE THE SAME METHOD TO MAKE THE TASSEL ON THE TAIL. FINALLY, YOU WILL REQUIRE A SMALLER NEEDLE FOR THIS STEP. SEW THE BELL ONTO THE NECK WITH YARN. USE THE SAME THREADING METHOD AS THE NOSTRILS.
