



BEFORE BEGINNING THIS PROJECT, YOU'LL HAVE TO LEARN SOME BASIC CROCHET TECHNIQUES: MAGIC LOOP, DOUBLE CROCHET AND FASTENING OFF. TO START WITH, USE THE CROCHET HOOK TO CREATE A MAGIC LOOP.




FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, WRAP THE YARN AROUND YOUR FINGER TWICE. LEAVE AT LEAST A 15cm TAIL, UNTIL YOU BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THIS METHOD.




USE YOUR THUMB AND INDEX FINGER TO HOLD THE HOOK. LEAVE 4cm FROM THE TIP OF THE HOOK TO YOUR FINGERS, REFER TO PICTURE 'A'. PLACE YOUR MIDDLE FINGER ON THE HOOK I.5cm AWAY FROM THE TIP. KEEP THE OTHER TWO FINGERS CLOSE TO THE CROCHET HOOK, JUST AS PICTURE 'B' SHOWS.




FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, HOLD THE LOOP WITH 2 FINGERS THEN GRAB THE WORKING YARN WITH THE HOOK AND PULL IT BACK THROUGH THE LOOP.




YOU WILL HAVE ONE LOOP ON THE HOOK.



PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH THE HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.




INSERT THE HOOK PASSING THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW. THIS CREATES A CHAIN STITCH.




PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.






DOUBLE CROCHET MADE, PLEASE NOTE THESE TWO STEPS MAKE ONE STITCH.






INSERT THE HOOK THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.




PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW AGAIN. A SLIP STITCH IS MADE.



WHEN YOU FINISH THE FIRST ROUND, YOU MAY USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE WHEN CHANGING THE COLOUR OF THREAD TO MARK WHERE THE BEGINNING OF THE ROUND IS.




WHEN YOU REACH THE LAST STITCH IN THE ROUND OR ROW, CUT OFF THE YARN LEAVING A 12cm TAIL, SLIP THE END OF THE YARN THROUGH THE STITCH AND PULL IT TO TIGHTEN THE LOOP. WEAVE THE TAIL INTO YOUR WORK









INCREASE DOUBLE CROCHET





MOUTH ON THE HEAD

STUFF THE MOUTH, THEN PLACE IT IN THE APPROPRIATE POSITION ON THE HEAD. USING THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE MOUTH, SEW IN AND OUT TO ATTACH THE MOUTH TO THE HEAD. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC, SEWING ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE MOUTH IS SECURELY ATTACHED. THEN, PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT IT OFF. THREAD BROWN YARN THROUGH THE PLASTIC NEEDLE, INSERT IT FROM THE BACK OF THE HEAD, LEAVING A TAIL, AND BRING IT OUT AT THE NOSE POSITION. SEW THE TEXTURE OF THE NOSE AND MOUTH. ONCE THE STITCHING IS COMPLETE, PULL THE THREAD OUT FROM WHERE IT WAS INSERTED, TIE BOTH THREADS IN A KNOT, CUT OFF THE YARN, AND USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE TO TUCK THE EXCESS YARN INTO THE HEAD.





EARS ON THE HEAD


TAKE OUT THE CROCHETED EARS AND PLACE THEM IN THE APPROPRIATE POSITION ON THE HEAD. USING THE TAIL YARN LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE EARS, SEW IN AND OUT TO ATTACH THE EARS TO THE HEAD. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC, SEWING ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE EARS ARE SECURELY ATTACHED. THEN, PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT IT OFF. REPEAT THE SAME STEPS TO MAKE THE OTHER EAR.





HANDS AND LEGS ON THE BODY

TAKE OUT THE CROCHETED HANDS AND LEGS, THEN PLACE ONE HAND IN THE APPROPRIATE POSITION ON THE BODY. USING THE TAIL YARN LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE HAND, SEW IN AND OUT TO ATTACH THE HAND TO THE BODY. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC, SEWING ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE HAND IS SECURELY ATTACHED. THEN, PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT IT OFF. REPEAT THE SAME STEPS TO MAKE THE OTHER HAND AND BOTH LEGS.





HEAD ON THE BODY

TAKE OUT THE COMPLETED HEAD AND PLACE IT ON TOP OF THE BODY. USING THE TAIL YARN LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE HEAD, SEW IN AND OUT TO ATTACH THE HEAD TO THE BODY. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC, SEWING ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE HEAD IS SECURELY ATTACHED. THEN, PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT IT OFF.





SNOWFLAKES ON THE JUMPER

FINALLY, THREAD THE WHITE YARN [W] THROUGH THE PLASTIC NEEDLE, INSERT IT FROM THE BACK OF THE BODY, LEAVING A TAIL, AND PULL IT OUT FROM THE FRONT. FOLLOW THE BELOW ILLUSTRATION TO SEW THE SNOWFLAKES AND THE FRENCH STITCH METHOD FOR THE ROUND DOTS AS EMBELLISHMENTS. ONCE FINISHED, PULL THE YARN OUT FROM THE POINT WHERE IT WAS INSERTED, THE A KNOT WITH THE TWO TAIL THREADS, CUT OFF THE EXCESS YARN, AND USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE TO TUCK THE TAIL THREADS INTO THE BODY.
