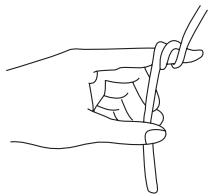


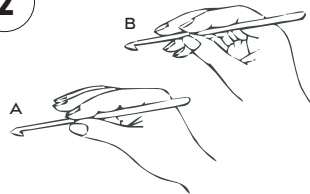
BEFORE BEGINNING THIS PROJECT, YOU'LL HAVE TO LEARN SOME BASIC CROCHET TECHNIQUES: MAGIC LOOP, DOUBLE CROCHET AND FASTENING OFF. TO START WITH, USE THE CROCHET HOOK TO CREATE A MAGIC LOOP.

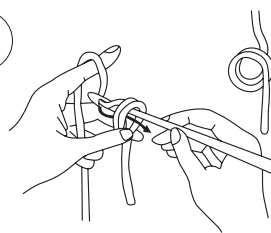
FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, WRAP THE YARN AROUND YOUR FINGER TWICE. LEAVE AT LEAST A 15cm TAIL, UNTIL YOU BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THIS METHOD.

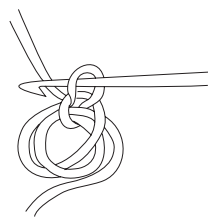
USE YOUR THUMB AND INDEX FINGER TO HOLD THE HOOK. LEAVE 4cm FROM THE TIP OF THE HOOK TO YOUR FINGERS, REFER TO PICTURE 'A'. PLACE YOUR MIDDLE FINGER ON THE HOOK 1.5cm AWAY FROM THE TIP. KEEP THE OTHER TWO FINGERS CLOSE TO THE CROCHET HOOK, JUST AS PICTURE 'B' SHOWS.

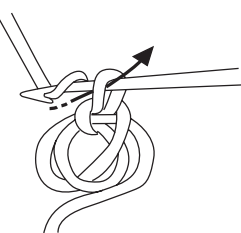
FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, HOLD THE LOOP WITH 2 FINGERS THEN GRAB THE WORKING YARN WITH THE HOOK AND PULL IT BACK THROUGH THE LOOP.

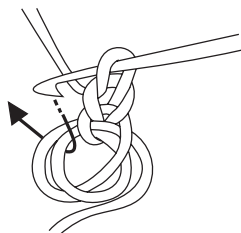
YOU WILL HAVE ONE LOOP ON THE HOOK.

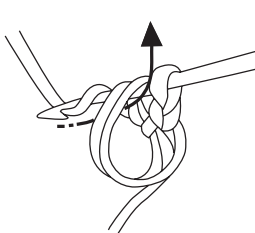
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH THE HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.

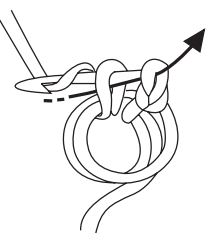
INSERT THE HOOK PASSING THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW. THIS CREATES A CHAIN STITCH.

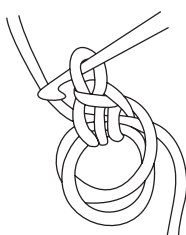
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.

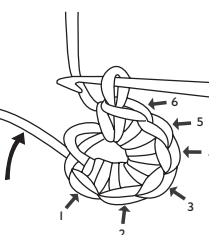

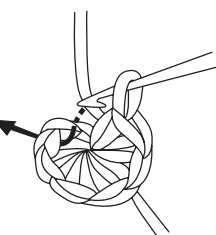
DOUBLE CROCHET MADE, PLEASE NOTE THESE TWO STEPS MAKE ONE STITCH.

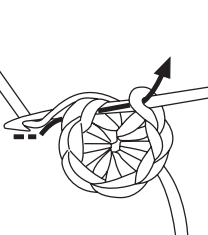
KEEP DRAWING THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP FROM THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW. REPEAT STEPS 7 & 8 SIX MORE TIMES, COMPLETING 7 DC.

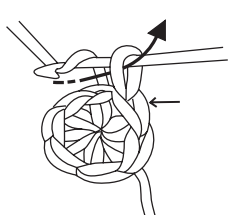
INSERT THE HOOK THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.

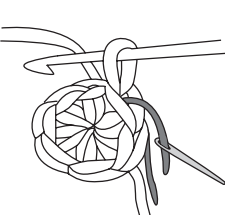
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.

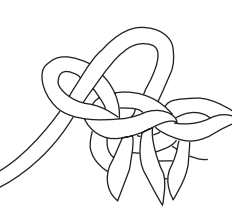
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW AGAIN. A SLIP STITCH IS MADE.

WHEN YOU FINISH THE FIRST ROUND, YOU MAY USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE WHEN CHANGING THE COLOUR OF THREAD TO MARK WHERE THE BEGINNING OF THE ROUND IS.

WHEN YOU REACH THE LAST STITCH IN THE ROUND OR ROW, CUT OFF THE YARN LEAVING A 12cm TAIL, SLIP THE END OF THE YARN THROUGH THE STITCH AND PULL IT TO TIGHTEN THE LOOP. WEAVE THE TAIL INTO YOUR WORK

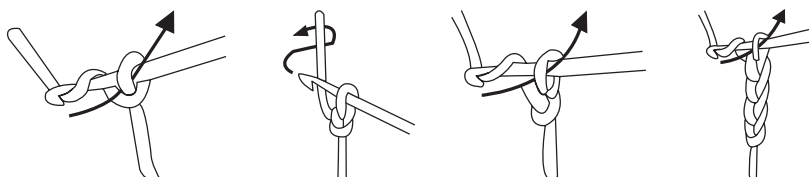

INC**INCREASE DOUBLE CROCHET**

ADDITIONAL STITCH IN THE SAME SPACE MEANS YOU REPEAT A DOUBLE CROCHET TWICE FOR THE SAME STITCH SPACE LIKE THE ILLUSTRATION.

DEC**DECREASE DOUBLE CROCHET (DC2TOG)****SS****SLIP STITCH****TO MAKE THE LEGS AND BODY**

YOU WILL USE ORANGE YARN [O], BLACK YARN [B], WHITE YARN [W], RED YARN [R] AND GREEN YARN [G] FOR THE LEGS AND BODY.

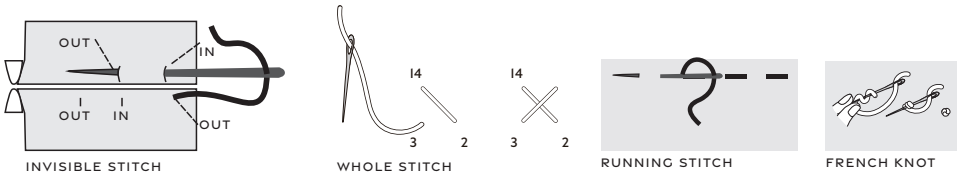
YOU WILL USE BLACK YARN [B], WHITE YARN [W], RED YARN [R] AND GREEN YARN [G] FOR THE ARMS.

BEAK ON THE HEAD

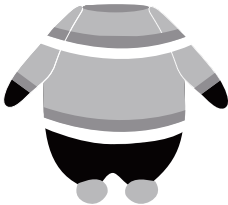
STUFF THE BEAK, THEN PLACE IT IN THE APPROPRIATE POSITION ON THE HEAD. USING THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE BEAK, SEW IN AND OUT TO ATTACH THE BEAK TO THE HEAD. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC. SEW ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE BEAK IS SECURELY ATTACHED, THEN PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT THE YARN.

ARMS ON THE BODY

PLACE THE FIRST ARM IN THE POSITION WHERE YOU WANT IT TO BE ATTACHED TO THE BODY. USING THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE ARM, SEW BACK AND FORTH BETWEEN THE ARM TOP AND THE BODY TO SECURE THE ARM. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC. SEW ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE ARM IS SECURELY ATTACHED, THEN PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT THE YARN. REPEAT THE SAME STEPS TO SEW ON THE SECOND ARM.

HEAD ON THE BODY

PLACE THE HEAD ON TOP OF THE BODY. USING THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE BODY, SEW IN AND OUT TO ATTACH THE HEAD TO THE BODY. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC. SEW ALL THE WAY AROUND UNTIL THE HEAD IS SECURELY ATTACHED, THEN PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT THE YARN.

MAKING A SNOWFLAKE JUMPER

FINALLY, THREAD THE WHITE YARN THROUGH THE PLASTIC NEEDLE, INSERT IT FROM THE BACK OF THE BODY, LEAVING A TAIL, AND PULL IT OUT FROM THE FRONT. USE THE GIVEN STITCH TO SEW THE SNOWFLAKES, STARS, AND ROUND DOTS AS EMBELLISHMENTS. ONCE FINISHED, PULL THE YARN OUT FROM THE POINT WHERE IT WAS INSERTED, TIE A KNOT WITH THE TWO TAIL THREADS, CUT OFF THE EXCESS YARN, AND USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE TO TUCK THE TAIL THREADS INTO THE BODY.
