


BEFORE BEGINNING THIS PROJECT, YOU'LL HAVE TO LEARN SOME BASIC CROCHET TECHNIQUES: MAGIC LOOP, DOUBLE CROCHET AND FASTENING OFF. TO START WITH, USE THE CROCHET HOOK TO CREATE A MAGIC LOOP.




FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, WRAP THE YARN AROUND YOUR FINGER TWICE. LEAVE AT LEAST A 15cm TAIL, UNTIL YOU BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THIS METHOD.




USE YOUR THUMB AND INDEX FINGER TO HOLD THE HOOK. LEAVE 4cm FROM THE TIP OF THE HOOK TO YOUR FINGERS, REFER TO PICTURE 'A'. PLACE YOUR MIDDLE FINGER ON THE HOOK I.5cm AWAY FROM THE TIP. KEEP THE OTHER TWO FINGERS CLOSE TO THE CROCHET HOOK, JUST AS PICTURE 'B' SHOWS.




FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, HOLD THE LOOP WITH 2 FINGERS THEN GRAB THE WORKING YARN WITH THE HOOK AND PULL IT BACK THROUGH THE LOOP.




YOU WILL HAVE ONE LOOP ON THE HOOK.




PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH THE HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.






PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.






DOUBLE CROCHET MADE, PLEASE NOTE THESE TWO STEPS MAKE ONE STITCH.






INSERT THE HOOK THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.




PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW AGAIN. A SLIP STITCH IS MADE.



WHEN YOU FINISH THE FIRST ROUND, YOU MAY USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE WHEN CHANGING THE COLOUR OF THREAD TO MARK WHERE THE BEGINNING OF THE ROUND IS.



WHEN YOU REACH THE LAST STITCH IN THE ROUND OR ROW, CUT OFF THE YARN LEAVING A 12cm TAIL, SLIP THE END OF THE YARN THROUGH THE STITCH AND PULL IT TO TIGHTEN THE LOOP. WEAVE THE TAIL INTO YOUR WORK



## ARMS ON THE BODY

STUFF THE ARMS, THEN PLACE THE FIRST ARM IN THE POSITION WHERE YOU WANT IT TO BE ATTACHED TO THE BODY. USING THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE ARM, SEW BACK AND FORTH BETWEEN THE ARM TOP AND THE BODY TO SECURE THE ARM. USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN THROUGH THE FABRIC. SEW ALL THE WAY AROUDU UNTIL THE ARM IS SECURELY ATTACHED, THEN PULL THE YARN OUT FROM A POSITION FARTHER FROM THE SEWING AREA AND CUT THE YARN. THEN, REPEAT THE SAME STEPS TO SEW ON THE SECOND ARM.





#### STAR ON THE BODY

PREPARE THE CROCHETED STAR, USE THE TAIL LEFT AFTER COMPLETING THE STAR, THREAD IT THROUGH THE PLASTIC NEEDLE, AND SEW IT ON THE TOP OF THE BODY. ONCE SECURED, PASS THE PLASTIC NEEDLE THROUGH THE BODY AND CUT THE YARN.





# BEADS AND BELLS ON THE BODY

PREPARE THE BEADS, BELLS, EMBROIDERY THREAD, AND EMBROIDERY NEEDLE. SEPARATE ONE SIX-STRAND EMBROIDERY THREAD INTO SIX SINGLE STRANDS, THEN THREAD ONE STRAND THROUGH THE EMBROIDERY NEEDLE. INSERT THE NEEDLE THROUGH FOUR STITCHES OF THE BODY, LEAVING A TAIL WITHOUT PULLING THE THREAD ALL THE WAY THROUGH. SEW A BEAD ONTO ANY POSITION ON THE BODY, LOOPING THE THREAD AROUND THE BEAD TWICE. THEN, INSERT THE EMBROIDERY NEEDLE THROUGH A STITCH AT THE POSITION OF THE NEXT BEAD AND SEW THE SECOND BEAD. AFTER ALL THE BEADS AND BELLS ARE ATTACHED, PULL THE EMBROIDERY THREAD THROUGH A STITCH. FINALLY, CUT OFF THE TAIL.
