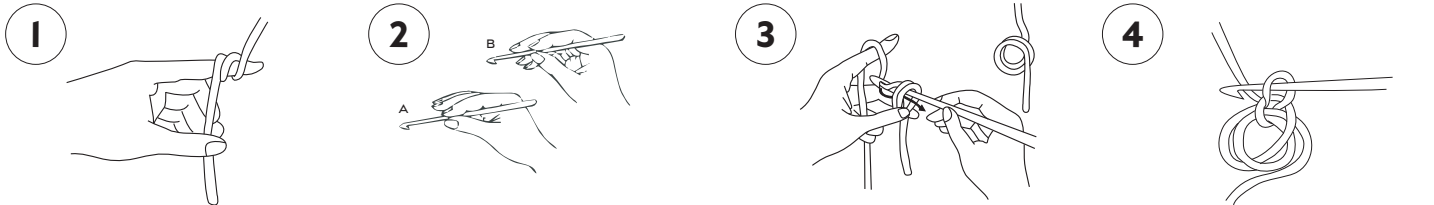

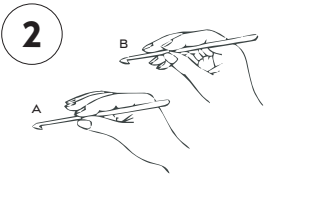

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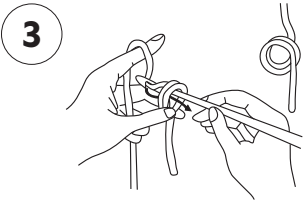
BEFORE BEGINNING THIS PROJECT, YOU'LL HAVE TO LEARN SOME BASIC CROCHET TECHNIQUES: MAGIC LOOP, DOUBLE CROCHET AND FASTENING OFF. TO START WITH, USE THE CROCHET HOOK TO CREATE A MAGIC LOOP.



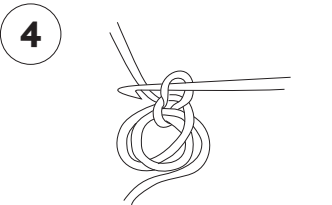
FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, WRAP THE YARN AROUND YOUR FINGER TWICE. LEAVE AT LEAST A 15cm TAIL, UNTIL YOU BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THIS METHOD.



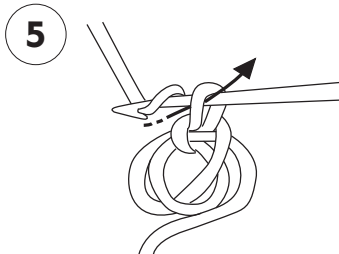
USE YOUR THUMB AND INDEX FINGER TO HOLD THE HOOK. LEAVE 4cm FROM THE TIP OF THE HOOK TO YOUR FINGERS. REFER TO PICTURE 'A'. PLACE YOUR MIDDLE FINGER ON THE HOOK 15cm AWAY FROM THE TIP. KEEP THE OTHER TWO FINGERS CLOSE TO THE CROCHET HOOK, JUST AS PICTURE 'B' SHOWS.



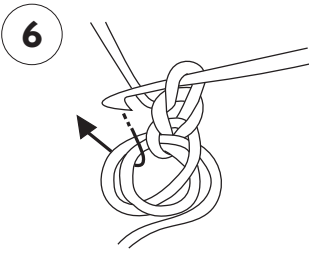
FOLLOWING THE ILLUSTRATION, HOLD THE LOOP WITH 2 FINGERS THEN GRAB THE WORKING YARN WITH THE HOOK AND PULL IT BACK THROUGH THE LOOP.



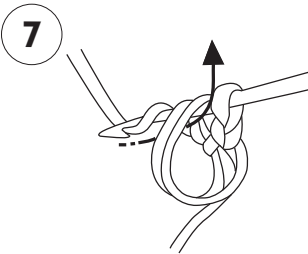
YOU WILL HAVE ONE LOOP ON THE HOOK.



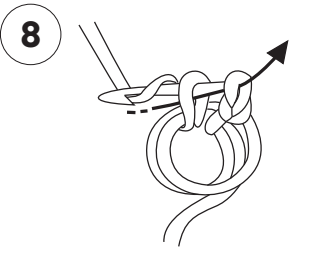
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH THE HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



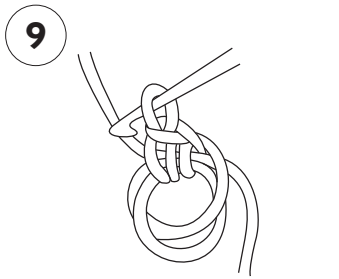
INSERT THE HOOK PASSING THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW. THIS CREATES A CHAIN STITCH.



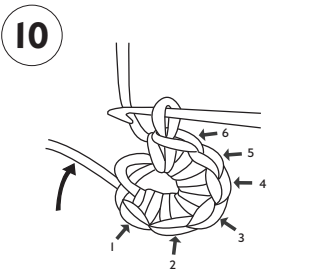
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



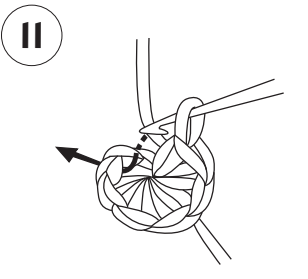

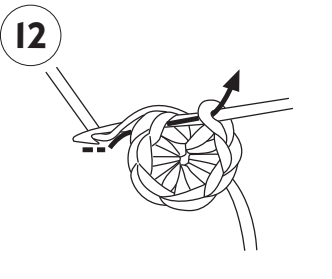
DOUBLE CROCHET MADE, PLEASE NOTE THESE TWO STEPS MAKE ONE STITCH.



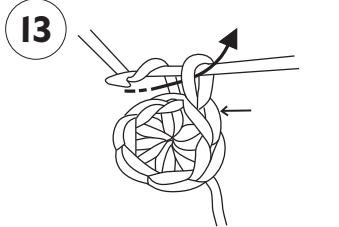
KEEP DRAWING THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP FROM THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW. REPEAT STEPS 7 & 8 SIX MORE TIMES, COMPLETING 7DC.



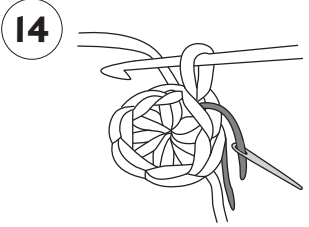
INSERT THE HOOK THROUGH THE LOOP FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



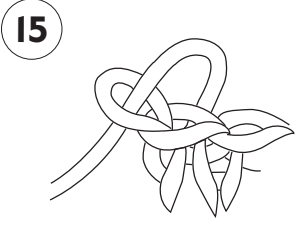
PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW.



PULL THE WORKING YARN THROUGH THE LOOP WITH YOUR HOOK FOLLOWING THE DIRECTION OF THE ARROW AGAIN. A SLIP STITCH IS MADE.



WHEN YOU FINISH THE FIRST ROUND, YOU MAY USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE WHEN CHANGING THE COLOUR OF THREAD TO MARK WHERE THE BEGINNING OF THE ROUND IS.



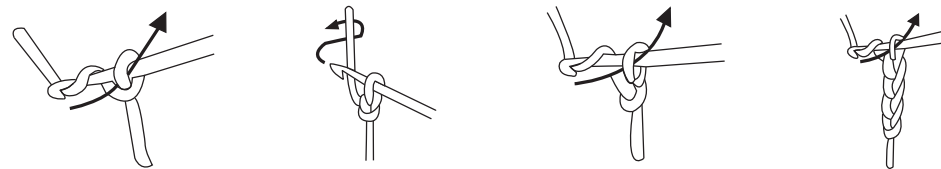
WHEN YOU REACH THE LAST STITCH IN THE ROUND OR ROW, CUT OFF THE YARN LEAVING A 12cm TAIL, SLIP THE END OF THE YARN THROUGH THE STITCH AND PULL IT TO TIGHTEN THE LOOP. WEAVE THE TAIL INTO YOUR WORK.

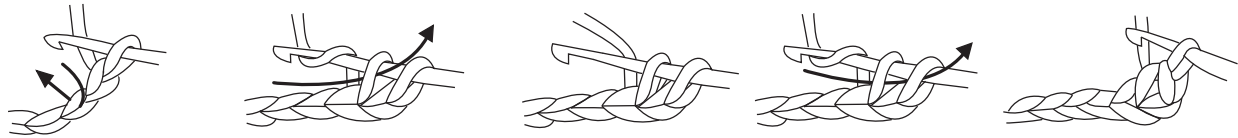

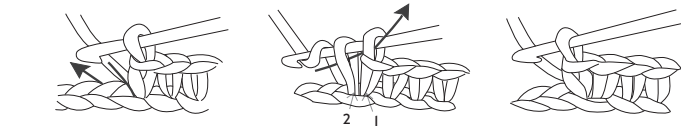

DC DOUBLE CROCHET

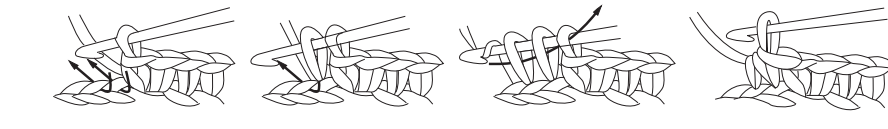


INC INCREASE DOUBLE CROCHET

DEC DECREASE DOUBLE CROCHET (DC2TOG)



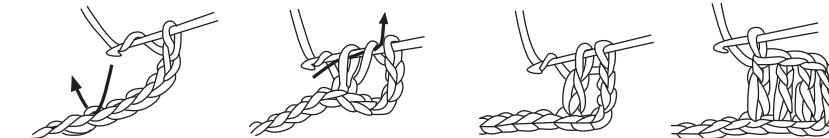

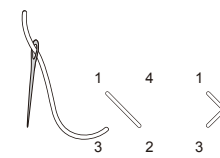

ATTACHING THE MUSHROOMS:

JOIN ALL PARTS TOGETHER:



CROSS STITCHES

TAKE A MUSHROOM AND THREAD THE PLASTIC NEEDLE. INSERT THE NEEDLE INTO ANY POSITION ON THE MUSHROOM CAP, LEAVING A TAIL, AND PULL IT OUT AT A FARTHER POSITION. USE THE CROSS-STITCH METHOD TO SEW CROSSES AS EMBELLISHMENTS ON ANY PART OF THE MUSHROOM CAP. ONCE THE EMBELLISHMENTS ARE COMPLETE, PULL THE THREAD OUT FROM THE ENTRY POINT, TIE A KNOT WITH BOTH ENDS, AND CUT OFF THE YARN. USE THE PLASTIC NEEDLE TO TUCK THE YARN ENDS INTO THE MUSHROOM.

REPEAT THE SAME STEPS TO COMPLETE THE OTHER TWO MUSHROOMS.
